







## CLEANLINESS

<p><b>Category 1 - Clean and Dry</b> Sheep in this category will be accepted for slaughter without any special treatment.</p> <p><b>Dry</b> Clean with regard to dirt/dung. Very minor amounts of loosely adherent straw/bedding</p>	
<p><b>Category 2 - Slightly Dirty</b> Sheep in this category will be accepted for slaughter without any special treatment.</p> <p><b>Dry</b> Light contamination with dirt/dung. Small amounts of loosely adherent straw/bedding</p>	
<p><b>Category 3 - Dirty</b> Sheep in this category will be rejected for slaughter except in circumstances which are exceptional, e.g. animal welfare grounds, disease control reasons</p> <p><b>Dry/Damp</b> Significant contamination with dirt/dung and/or significant amounts of adherent straw/bedding</p>	
<p><b>Category 4 - Very Dirty</b> Sheep in this category will be rejected for slaughter except in circumstances which are exceptional, e.g. animal welfare grounds, disease control reasons</p> <p><b>Dry/Damp</b> Heavily contaminated with dirt/dung, heavily clagged and/or significant amounts of adherent bedding</p>	
<p><b>Category 5 - Filthy and Wet</b> Sheep in this category will be rejected for slaughter. Very wet/very heavily contaminated with dirt/dung and/or very heavily clagged and/or a lot of bedding adherent to the coat</p>
